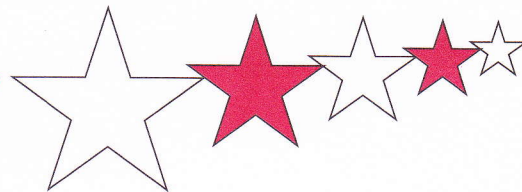

## Almost there!!!

Firstly, thank you for all your patience. All of us here at Cosmik Aviation have been working flat out since December trying to answer all the questions asked of us by the CAA and understand and evaluate all aspects of the Swiss accident report which has many errors and unanswered questions in it.

Last week we sent a team (including Dave Simpson, our Engineering Design Consultant and Francis Donaldson, Chief Engineer LAA) out to the Czech Republic who then took a trip on to Poland to visit the factory of one of the metal suppliers, together with representatives from Evektor and the Czech LAA.

Information gathered was passed back to the CAA, who, after a very lengthy meeting yesterday have finally agreed that we are almost there!

The CAA are going to issue an updated MPD next week which will allow us to start the wing testing. The new MPD will also allow us to release aircraft, that pass the test, back to normal operating conditions. The MPD will be extended until the end of March 2011 to give us time to get round to you all, whilst still staying in business.

We now have a purpose made trailer for transporting wings, which could be borrowed by prior arrangement. Where possible we would test your wings on the day you bring them to us, avoiding lots of unnecessary travelling. This option is likely to push you higher up the testing queue and there will be no charge for borrowing the trailer. The trailer will need to be returned to us within 24 hours however, as we will be using it ourselves if we get any failed wings etc.

The last few months have been a very stressful time for us, however the patience and understanding of all of you has made it bearable.

We will contact flying schools first to arrange testing of their aircraft and then follow on with individuals as soon as we can. We anticipate that the first batch of tests will begin on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> March, assuming no further hold ups occur.
